We will enjoy visiting this hidden gem nestled in the Surrey Hills, a 50 min drive from Teddington. There are paintings and sculptures to be explored at Watts Gallery and the current exhibition, **Liberating Fashion: Aesthetic Dress in Victorian Portraits** showcases masterpieces by the Victorian Greats, including Watts, Leighton, Burne-Jones, Alma-Tadema and Tissot alongside fashion, photography and drawings. It sheds new light on how Aestheticism led to a re-assessment of perceptions of beauty and heralded a fashion reform.

For those who can manage an uphill 300 yard walk, a visit to the Watts Cemetery Chapel, a red brick Arts and Crafts masterpiece is not to be missed. The interior is a beautiful mix of Art Nouveau and Pre-Raphaelite influenced design. Bring sturdy walking shoes.

The Tea Shop near the Gallery is a delightful cafe in the old pottery where we can relax and enjoy lunch. There is also an on-site shop with unique gifts.

Access to the Gallery building:

There are level pathways from the Car Parks to the Visitor Centre, Tea Shop and to the Gallery's front gate. From the front gate there is a slightly inclined uneven pathway to the front door of the gallery. Wheelchairs can be booked.
