**PITZHANGER MANOR 19 JUNE**

**Architecture - Art - History -  
Park - Gardens - Cafe - Shop**

We will travel by 33 and 65 buses to Ealing and alight at Christchurch. We will then go into **Christ the Saviour Church** which is open to visit. It is very attractive inside. Although consecrated in 1852 and built in a mock Gothic style, it has a most unusual modern stained glass window above the altar. There is a lot of decoration of the woodwork with gilding and pattern. After we have had our fill of the church, we will walk the short distance to Pitzhanger Manor. From midday on Wednesdays there is a bargain entrance fee for seniors.

**Pitzhanger Manor** is the former country residence of Sir John Soane. It has recently been renovated to an exceptionally high standard to his original colour schemes with extra interactive displays in the rooms. Adjoining the house is his former studio now transformed into an Art Gallery that presently has an exhibition of Anish Kapoor of sculptures that echo Soane's complex use of mirrors and light to double and dissolve space. The manor is sited in delightful gardens adjoining Walpole Park where there are lakes and lots of quirky signs to read.

**Soane's Kitchen** is a restaurant next door which has waitress-served lunches. In the grounds is the **Pitzhanger Pantry** which offers drinks, toasted sandwiches and cakes. In the nearby streets are several other eating places. There is a small shop selling classy souvenirs.
