WILLIAM MORRIS GALLERY
WEDNESDAY 11 JULY 2018

The William Morris Gallery is the former childhood home of William Morris. It was given to Walthamstow Council by a subsequent owner and converted into a gallery about the life and work of William Morris. The house is set in Lloyd Park.

We will walk from Walthamstow Central Underground Station through the end of Walthamstow Market, past ethnic shops and Victorian terrace houses to the William Morris Gallery, formerly known as the Water House.

The house is a very attractive building dating from about 1740. Inside there are galleries about the various strands of the life and work of William Morris. There are also two short term exhibitions - one called 'Weaving New Worlds' and the other displaying work by a Japanese artist influenced by William Morris. The park has a William Morris inspired garden as well as Victorian style formal terraced flower beds and a serpentine lake with ducks. The two cafés offer a selection of freshly made sandwiches, salads, savouries, artisan cakes and hot and cold drinks.

Access: The William Morris Gallery is fully accessible, with an accessible entrance, accessible toilets and lift access to all floors. There is also Blue Badge parking – see more on their website.
